is a private, nonprofit organization dedicated to furthering the independence, self-reliance and dignity of individuals with developmental disabilities.



## Residential Services

provides housing and assistance to individuals with developmental disabilities who require supervision and training in order to enhance their ability to succeed in the community. All homes and apartments are located throughout Montgomery and Prince George's Counties and have live-in support. ALU(Alternative Living Units), Group Home and CSLA (Community Supported Living Arrangement) staff support in the home is intended to promote independence, social integration and strengthening of family relationships. ALU provide housing in a residential set-

ting for one to three individuals, and group home provide a residence for four individuals. Funding for this program comes from the Developmental Disabilities Administration Montgomery County and other appropriate services.

## Objectives of Residential Services

- Provide high quality and least restrictive housing and program services appropriate to the changing needs of the residents served.
- Ensure residents have access to and voluntary participation in integrated community activities.
- Maintain and encourage broad-based resident, professional, and family input in determining individual's program development and direction.
- Provide monitoring and evaluation of program quality and effectiveness and initiate improvements as necessary.
